# **1. What's different about a dementia friendly concert?**

This performance is designed to be friendly, informal, and relaxed. You can stay for all of the concert, or some of it, come and go as you please, walk around, make noise, and move as little or as much as you like. The concert is performed by two friendly exceptional young artists who are trained in delivering these types of performances for people living with dementia.

Fun! This concert is based around the theme of food. It is interactive and there will be opportunities to join in. You'll be able to sing-a-long to recognisable tunes as a group but no one will be singled out. You can move around, or just sit and listen on your own, it's entirely up to you.

Whether you have dementia yourself, or a member of your family has dementia, or you care for someone with dementia; or even none of these things and you fancy trying something a bit different, this is a concert for you.
